SUBJECT: Amending the *FFYs 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program* / Proposed

Resolutions 23-33 through 23-35

NYSDOT has requested changes to the *FFYs 2023-2027 TIP*. The changes came to light after the November 9, 2023 Planning Committee meeting; however, they are time sensitive and cannot wait until the February meeting for consideration. In lieu of Planning Committee consideration, the proposed changes were presented to the TIP Development Committee to ensure that there were no objections.

On November 27, the Governor's office announced a list of projects for roadway repaving and resiliency enhancements on State Routes. The list includes eight projects in our region, seven of which are 100% state funded. The projects are:

Federally Funded:

 Rt 21 from the Village of Manchester to the Village of Palmyra Route 33A from the bridge over Black Creek to Route 252 in the Town of Chili

State Funded:

- I-390 from Exit 6 (Sonyea) to Exit 7 (Mount Morris), in the Town of Groveland
- Route 250 from the Village of Webster to Lake Road in the Town of Webster
- Route 39 within the Village of Perry
- Route 31A from Route 98 to Hulberton Road in the Towns of Albion, Barre, and Clarendon
- Route 33 from the City of Batavia to the Village of Corfu in the Towns of Batavia and Pembroke
- Route 14 from the former Village of Lyons to Route 104 in the Towns of Lyons and Sodus

These projects represent new funding to the region.

Additionally, bids have been opened on two other NYSDOT projects that significantly exceed the funds programmed. The bids for both projects were rejected. One project has already been rebid and NYSDOT-Main Office is providing supplemental funds.

The other project, for bridge improvements at multiple locations, is being repackaged with fewer locations. To stay within the available funding, the number of bridges being addressed is being reduced from 24 to 10. The Plans, Specifications & Estimates document is needed before the next GTC quarterly Board meeting.
