RESOLUTION

Resolution 23-2 *Accepting the Regional Traffic Operations Center Performance Monitoring and Evaluation System as evidence of completion of UPWP Task 7620*

WHEREAS,

1. The *FY 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program* includes Task 7620, Genesee-Finger Lakes Regional Performance Measurement Monitoring and Evaluation System, for the purpose of establishing a program for evaluating regional transportation system performance data and reporting performance measures based on that data;
2. Said Task evaluated best practices for monitoring and measuring transportation system performance; inventoried operations data and analysis tools currently available at the James R. Pond Regional Traffic Operations Center (RTOC); identified gaps and associated needs in data collection, management, and reporting; determined the functional requirements of a ticketing and dispatch system for managing transportation service delivery and extracting performance data; and developed a web-based system for tracking service calls, monitoring response activities, and extracting operations data to use in monitoring and evaluating RTOC service delivery;
3. Said Task has been completed and has resulted in the *Regional Traffic Operations Center Performance Monitoring and Evaluation System*, which enables more efficient transportation system performance data collection and analysis; and
4. Said System has been reviewed by GTC staff and member agencies through the GTC committee process and has been found to be consistent with the goals, objectives, and recommendations of the Long Range Transportation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. That the Genesee Transportation Council hereby accepts the *Regional Traffic Operations Center Performance Monitoring and Evaluation System* as evidence of completion of UPWP Task 7620; and
2. That this resolution takes effect immediately.
