**SUBJECT:** Amending the *FFYs 2023-2027* and *2026-2030 Transportation Improvement* 

Program / Proposed Resolutions 25-24 through 25-35

NYSDOT, Wayne County, the City of Rochester, the Village of Medina, and RGRTA have requested changes to the *FFYs 2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIPs*. The Planning Committee reviewed the following proposed changes on August 14, 2025, and recommends favorable action for Proposed Resolutions 25-24 through 25-35.

The amendment requests and supporting documents have been grouped and are provided for your consideration in the following attachments:

Approve proposed Resolutions 25-24 through 25-35 amending the *FFYs 2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIPs*.

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### **Attachment A – TIP Amendments**

### Main Office Funded Projects

**1. Proposed Council Resolution 25-24** (Amending the FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Increasing the Federal Aid of the FFY 2026 Construction phase for the Culvert Replacement at Various Locations in Livingston, Monroe, Ontario Counties project) (TIP #H23-32-R43, PIN 4LC103) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the Federal Aid of a FFY 2026 Construction phase from \$2,710,215 to \$3,387,375 Federal).

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) – Flex Program managed by NYSDOT Main Office. There is no impact to Planning Target. NYSDOT's request is to reduce Federal Aid to better balance available Main Office funding for the 4LC projects. There is no change to the project total.

**2. Proposed Council Resolution 25-25** (Amending the FFYs *2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIP* by Adding a project and deferring phases of the Maple Ridge Road Corridor Active Transportation project)

(TIP #N23-16-OR2, PIN 476142) – Village of Medina

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$1,367,900 (\$1,094,280 Federal); Defer a FFY 2025 ROW Acquisition phase of \$50,900 (\$40,720 Federal) to FFY 2026; Defer a FFY 2025 Construction phase of \$870,444 (\$696,315 Federal) to FFY 2026; Defer a FFY 2025 Construction Inspection phase of \$152,456 (\$121,945 Federal) to FFY 2026.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) managed by NYSDOT Main Office. There is no change in the project scope or cost. This project is not currently included in the *2026-2030 TIP*, therefore the new TIP will need to be amended to add the requested project phases.

The Village of Medina is requesting a deferral of the Right-of-Way Acquisition, Construction, and Construction Inspection phases due to design challenges causing project delays.

**3. Proposed Council Resolution 25-26** (Amending the FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Increasing the Federal Aid of the FFY 2026 Construction phases of the Culvert Replacement at Various Locations in Livingston and Wyoming County project) (TIP #H23-30-R43, PIN 4LC101) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the Federal Aid of a FFY 2026 Construction phase from \$2,345,272 to \$2,931,590.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) - Flex Program managed by NYSDOT Main Office. There is no impact to Planning Target. NYSDOT's request is to increase Federal Aid on this Construction phase to better balance available Main Office funding for the 4LC projects. There is no change to the project total.

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**4. Proposed Council Resolution 25-27** (Amending the FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Modifying phases of the Rt 31 and Rt 36 (Washington St) Intersection Safety Enhancements) (TIP #H25-02-MN1, PIN106) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the FFY 2026 Construction phase from \$150,000 (\$135,000 Federal) to \$260,000 (\$234,000 Federal);

*Increase* the FFY 2026 Construction Inspection phase from \$15,000 (\$13,500 Federal) to \$26,000 (23,400 Federal);

*Defer* the FFY 2026 Construction phase of \$260,000 (\$234,000 Federal) to FFY 2027 *Defer* the FFY 2026 Construction Inspection phase of \$26,000 (\$23,400 Federal) to FFY 2027.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). NYSDOT's request is to increase the FFY 2026 Construction and Construction Inspection phases to reflect current estimate based on increased pedestrian facility needs and recent bid history. The request is also to defer the Construction and Construction Inspection phases from FFY 2026 to FFY 2027 as this project is meant to be coordinated with PIN 40C103 (Construction phases for PIN 40C103 are programmed in FFY 2027).

### Planning Target Funded Projects

**5. Proposed Council Resolution 25-28** (Amending the FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Deferring phases of the Rt 18 over Northrup Creek and Smith Creek Bridge Replacements project) (TIP #B20-24-MN1, PIN 401802) – NYSDOT

*Defer* the FFY 2026 Construction phase of \$4,766,000 (\$1,766,000 Federal) to FFY 2027; *Defer* the FFY 2026 Construction Inspection phase of \$477,000 (\$177,000 Federal) to FFY 2027.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) – Flex Program. NYSDOT's request is to defer the Construction and Construction Inspection phases due to delays caused by highway alignment modifications and drainage considerations.

### Statewide and Planning Target Funded Projects

**6. Proposed Council Resolution 25-29** (Amending the FFYs *2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIP* by Adding a project and deferring phases of the Rt 414 over CSX Bridge Rehabilitation (BIN 4060680) project)

(TIP #B17-29-WA2, PIN 441408) - NYSDOT

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$3,057,600 (\$2,446,000 Federal); Defer a FFY 2025 Construction phase of \$2,282,300 (\$1,825,800 Federal) to FFY 2027; Defer a FFY 2025 Construction Inspection phase of \$228,000 (\$182,400 Federal) to FFY 2027;

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Surface Transportation Block Grant – Flex Program managed by NYSDOT Main Office. There is no change in the project scope or

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cost. There is no impact to Planning Target. This project is not currently included in the *2026-2030 TIP*, therefore the new TIP will need to be amended to add the requested project phases.

NYSDOT is requesting a deferral of the Construction and Construction Inspection phases because an agreement with CSX has not been reached.

7. Proposed Council Resolution 25-30 (Amending the FFY 2026-2030 TIP by Modifying a phase of the Large Culvert Replacement – Part 2 project) (TIP #B20-27-MN3, PIN 4LC104) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the Federal Aid of a FFY 2026 Construction phase from \$0 to \$4,756,059; *Defer* a FFY 2026 Construction phase of \$15,853,530 (\$4,756,059 Federal) to FFY 2027.

The source of federal funds is the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) – Flex Program managed by NYSDOT Main Office. An offset is provided from other 4LC projects. There is no impact to Planning Target.

NYSDOT's request is to restore federal aid to this project to balance the budget of available Main Office funding for the 4LC projects. No change to project total. The request is also to defer the Construction phase due to the latest NYSDOT design project schedule.

8. Proposed Council Resolution 25-31 (Amending the FFY 2026-2030 TIP by Modifying a phase of the I-390 from Canal Bridge (Exit 16) to Rt 33A project) (TIP #H23-42-MN1, PIN 439095) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the FFY 2026 Construction phase of \$22,050,000 (\$20,845,000 Federal) to \$24,500,000 (\$23,050,000 Federal).

The sources of existing Federal Aid are the National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) and the National Highway Freight Program (NHFP). NYSDOT's request is to increase the Construction phase of this project to reflect the latest cost estimate. A reduction in Federal Aid on PIN 410D02 provides an offset.

**9. Proposed Council Resolution 25-32** (Amending the FFY *2023-2027 TIP* by Increasing the FFY 2025 Construction phases of the Pavement Markings for 2026 (Westside) project) (TIP #H20-70-R43, PIN 4T3525) – NYSDOT

*Increase* the FFY 2025 Construction phase of \$8,500,000 (\$4,114,000 Federal) to \$8,868,000 (\$4,552,000 Federal); *Increase* the FFY 2025 Construction Inspection phase of \$850,000 (\$411,000 Federal) to \$887,000 (\$176,000 Federal).

The source of existing Federal Aid is the National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) and the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds managed by NYSDOT Main Office. NYSDOT's request is to increase the Construction and Construction Inspection phases of this project to reflect the latest cost estimate.

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**10. Proposed Council Resolution 25-33** (Amending the FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Adding the City of Rochester 2024 Safe Streets for All Projects) – <u>City of Rochester</u>

Add four (4) projects with a Total Cost of \$41,712,000 (\$23,700,000 Federal).

 Supplemental Planning, Traffic Calming Demonstration Project and Project Monitoring (PIN 4CR027)

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$1,040,000 (\$832,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Preliminary Engineering phase of \$25,000 (\$20,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Detailed Design phase of \$25,000 (\$20,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Other phase of \$640,000 (\$512,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2028 Construction phase of \$300,000 (\$240,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2028 Construction Inspection phase of \$50,000 (\$10,000 Federal).

2. North Clinton Avenue Implementation Project (PIN 4CR028)

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$14,352,000 (\$6,340,000 Federal);

Add a Prior Year Preliminary Engineering phase of \$450,000 (\$0 Federal);

Add a Prior Year Detailed Design phase of \$450,000 (\$0 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Construction phase of \$11,752,000 (\$5,596,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Construction Inspection phase of \$1,700,000 (\$744,000 Federal).

3. <u>Chili Avenue and East Main Street Implementation Project</u> (PIN 4CR029)

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$14,690,000 (\$9,264,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Preliminary Engineering phase of \$612,500 (\$394,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2026 Detailed Design phase of \$612,500 (\$394,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2028 Construction phase of \$11,665,000 (\$7,380,000 Federal);

Add a FFY 2028 Construction Inspection phase of \$1,800,000 (\$1,096,000 Federal).

4. <u>Lexington Avenue Street Implementation Project</u> (PIN 4CR030)

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$11,630,000 (\$7,264,000 Federal); Add a FFY 2026 Preliminary Engineering phase of \$487,500 (\$310,000 Federal); Add a FFY 2026 Detailed Design phase of \$487,500 (\$310,000 Federal); Add a FFY 2028 Construction phase of \$9,235,000 (\$5,788,000 Federal); Add a FFY 2028 Construction Inspection phase of \$1,420,000 (\$856,000 Federal).

The source of Federal Aid is the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program. The City received an SS4A grant award and is currently in the final stages of executing the grant agreement with FHWA. This agreement allows for multiple projects, each with a separate schedule for delivery. FHWA has requested these projects be added to the TIP and STIP even though they are part of a direct agreement between the City of Rochester and FHWA and do not pass through New York State. These projects would be added to the TIP and STIP as Illustrative projects and will not impact fiscal constraint or the project delivery scorecard.

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**11. Proposed Council Resolution 25-34** (Amending the FFY *2023-2027 TIP* and FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Adding a project and deferring a phase of the RGRTA Hydrogen Fuel Cell Electric Buses project)

(TIP #T24-13-MN1, PIN 476148) - RGRTA

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$6,250,000 (\$5,000,000 Federal); Defer an Other phase of \$6,250,000 (\$5,000,000 Federal) from FFY 2025 to FFY 2026.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program. RGRTA requested that CMAQ funding for this project be transferred from FHWA to FTA in February 2025; however, this change has not yet been made. The transfer is currently in progress but will not be completed in time to obligate the funds in FFY 2025. Therefore, RGRTA is requesting a deferral of the CMAQ funds from FFY 2025 to FFY 2026. This change will not impact fiscal constraint and does not impact any other project. This project is not currently included in the *2026-2030 TIP*, therefore the new TIP will need to be amended to add the requested project phases.

**12. Proposed Council Resolution 25-35** (Amending the FFY *2023-2027 TIP* and FFY *2026-2030 TIP* by Adding a project and deferring a phase of the RGRTA Rural On Demand Service Pilot project)

(TIP #T24-14-MN1, PIN 476149) - RGRTA

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$4,447,985 (\$3,558,388 Federal); Defer an Other phase of \$4,447,985 (\$3,558,388 Federal) from FFY 2025 to FFY 2026.

The source of existing Federal Aid is the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program. RGRTA requested that CMAQ funding for this project be transferred from FHWA to FTA in February 2025; however, this change has not yet been made . The transfer is currently in progress but will not be completed in time to obligate the funds in FFY 2025. Therefore, RGRTA is requesting a deferral of the CMAQ funds from FFY 2025 to FFY 2026. This change will not impact fiscal constraint and does not impact any other project. This project is not currently included in the *2026-2030 TIP*, therefore the new TIP will need to be amended to add the requested project phases.

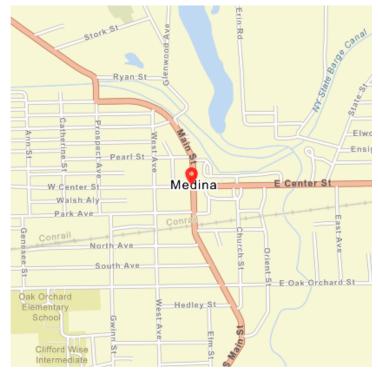

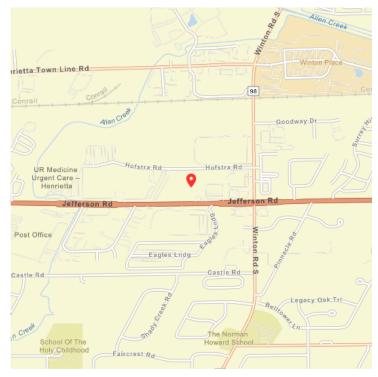

  - a. RGRTA Rural On Demand Service Pilot (TIP #T24-14-MN1, PIN 476149)

Add a new project with a Total Cost of \$4,447,985 (\$3,558,388 Federal); Defer an Other phase of \$4,447,985 (\$3,558,388 Federal) from FFY 2025 to FFY 2026.

- 3. The source of Federal funds is the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program;
- 4. The proposed changes are described on the attached Project Detail Sheet;
- 5. The timing of these projects is such that an amendment of the *2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIP* is now called for;
- 6. The Council is satisfied that this amendment of the *2023-2027* and *2026-2030 TIP* is within the limits of reasonably expected funding resources and is consistent with the Long Range Transportation Plan.
